CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS

Camp Courage is a story told over two periods of time - through depictions of present day and through flashbacks to 1997. Therefore, each character description mentions the time period/universe in which the character lives.

Milos the Great AKA Milos (Old) (*Present Day*) - Elderly director of Camp Courage. A charismatic and confident leader and storyteller who is beloved by all the campers at summer camp. Known worldwide for acts of heroism all starting at Camp Courage 25 years prior. Many myths and rumors have been spun about Milos.

Camp Assistant Director Old* (*Present Day*) - Attempts to be highly organized and punctual but is always falling behind due to the busy nature of the job. A passionate worker with an obvious love for making sure Camp Courage continues to function. Often frazzled and frustrated but with a kind and patient heart.

Apollo (*Present Day*) - A camper with a sunny disposition brimming with energy and excitement. A proud camper and highly motivated go-getter. In love with stories and fantasies, Apollo, along with their sibling Artemis, are huge Milos the Great fans.

Artemis (*Present Day*)- A camper with a strong will and can-do attitude. A reliable companion and strong demeanor. In love with stories and fantasies, Artemis along with their sibling Apollo are huge Milos the Great fans.

Circuit (*Present Day*) - Camper obsessed with staying connected to technology and social media. Up to date on trends and phone glued to their hand in case they get a notification.

Matcha (*Present Day*)- Camper who always doubts everything around them, Matcha is intelligent, but their skepticism gets in their way of enjoying life. Rather rough exterior but is thoughtful and caring on the inside.

Data (*Present Day*) - A math and science prodigy who is particularly passionate about statistics, research and of course data. Despite Data's short sighted focus on numbers, they still know how to have a good time out in nature.

Raven (1997) - An angsty camper, Raven finds time between roasting marshmallows and competing for the Medal of Courage to brood over the collective doom and darkness of the whole wide world. Dreadful as they are, Raven loves a good joke and is likable to the rest of the campers.

Original Camp Director Green (1997) Camp Director Green is complicated. They appear to be nice and supportive of the campers, but an internal struggle brewing within presents a great challenge.
