PROCEDURES FOR PREVENTION OF CORONAVIRUS TRANSMISSION AS OF 3/7/22
(THIS MAY CHANGE AS COUNTY HEALTH ORDERS CHANGE)

General Health Guidance:

- We will adhere to all state and county health guidelines as they are updated.
- No employees, production staff, or participants should come to the Hillcrest Center for the Arts if they have the following symptoms:
 - **Fever or chills (100.4 degrees or higher)**
 - **Cough**
 - **Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing**
 - **Fatigue**
 - **Muscle or body aches**
 - **Headache**
 - **New loss of taste or smell**
 - **Sore throat**
 - **Congestion or runny nose**
 - **Nausea or vomiting**
 - **Diarrhea**
- **Or if they have come into “Close Contact” with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19.** “Close Contact” is defined as, an individual “who was within 6 feet of a person with COVID-19 for at least 15 minutes over a 24-hour period starting from 2 days before symptoms appeared (or, for patients who do not have symptoms, 2 days prior to their test) until the time the patient is isolated.

You are also a close contact if:

- You provided care at the home of someone who is sick with COVID-19
- You had direct physical contact with the person (hugging or kissing them)
- You shared eating or drinking utensils
- They sneezed, coughed, or somehow got respiratory droplets on you.”

Be sure to:

- Wash your hands frequently: <https://www.cdc.gov/handwashing/>
- Face coverings over the nose and mouth are recommended, but not required, and will not be used by actors during performances.

Procedure If Any Staff or Participant Gets Sick During Rehearsals or Performances:

- If any participant or staff become ill or exhibit symptoms of coronavirus infection (listed above), they will be immediately isolated, and a guardian will be asked to immediately transport them for medical attention.
- Participants or staff that have been in close contact (defined above) with an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19, must isolate at home for at least 3 days if vaccinated and 5 days if unvaccinated. With a negative test on day 3 or 5, close contact may return on days 4 and 6 respectively.
- If a participant or staff member receives a positive COVID-19 test during the rehearsal or performance process time, or must quarantine due to risk of exposure, please notify producer, Megan McDonough, as soon as possible so that steps can be taken to ensure the safety of the rest of the team.
