Fairy Trial (Written by Mitchell Boring)

King Griffin: A majestic ruler with a lion's mane and eagle feathers, proud and commanding but had lost his powerful voice. Coughs and croaks with a sore throat.

Eska P. Goat: A small, timid goat with nervous energy, kind-hearted and honest but socially anxious. Accused of stealing the king's voice.

Elizabethical: A radiant fairy Defense Attorney with shimmering wings and professional attire. She is principled and warm, speaking in rhymes and alliterations.

Devi: Sleek and stylish Prosecuting Attorney with a devilish edge, manipulative and cunning with a flair for misdirection.

Judge Mintz: A wise owl in a judge's robe with spectacles, calm and impartial, maintaining order with fairness.

Bailiff Cliff: A tall buck with stag horns and a simple uniform, stoic and authoritative, speaking only when necessary.

Miss Placed: The presiding juror who is frazzled with scattered papers, well-meaning but often lost in her own disarray. Mislacing her belongings.

Miss Trust: A juror who is sharp-eyed and slightly paranoid, deeply skeptical and prone to conspiracy theories. Mistrusting everyone around her.

Miss Conduct: A juror who is dark and mysterious with a tough exterior, calm but intimidating with hints of underworld connections. An affinity for misconduct in the courtroom.

Miss Heard: A juror who is cheerful but out of place in mismatched attire, constantly confused and often mishearing things.

Advisor Ethos/Logos/Pathos: A shapeshifter embodying credibility, logic, or emotion, adapting their appearance and demeanor to fit each role.
