Code of Conduct

The Conejo Recreation & Park District (CRPD) is committed to providing fun, healthy, social, and educational recreational opportunities in a safe and welcoming environment suitable for all ages.

FOR THE SAFETY AND WELL-BEING OF ALL:

All persons using CRPD facilities, programs, or grounds must behave responsibly and respect the rights and dignity of others. The actions listed below—which are not intended to be an all-inclusive list of behaviors—help to ensure the quality of programs and public safety. All program participants, parents, spectators, employees, and volunteers must abide by this code of conduct:

- Respect the personal safety and property of others
- Properly use and do not misuse or intentionally damage the facility and equipment
- Use language and gestures suitable for a family-friendly environment
- Refrain from bullying: threatening, intimidating, or aggressive verbal or physical behavior toward others
- Observe program rules and regulations at all times

Failure to follow the code of conduct may result in consequences including:

- Notifying a parent or guardian (if the violation involves a minor)
- Requiring the participant to be picked-up or removed immediately
- Suspension from programs or facilities (as determined by management)
- Immediate removal from programs, facilities, and grounds
